## 203.2 ORDER OF THE REGULAR COOPERATIVE BOARD MEETING

## I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure consistency in the order of business at regular cooperative board meetings.

## II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It is the policy of the cooperative board to consider matters that come before it in a consistent and orderly manner.

## III. ORDER

- A. The cooperative board shall conduct an orderly cooperative board meeting. The cooperative board will, at all regular cooperative board meetings, follow an agenda order similar to:
  - 1. Call to order.
  - 2. Approval of agenda.
  - 3. Recognition of visitors.
  - 4. Guest Presenters
  - 5. Reports from Administration
  - 6. Approval of prior meeting minutes.
  - 7. Consent agenda.
    - a. Prior Meeting Minutes
    - b. Presentation of Bills and Finance
    - c. Personnel Matters
    - d. Policies
  - 8. Other old or unfinished business.
  - 9. New business.
  - 10. Other business.
  - 11. Adjournment.
- B. Items in this order may be considered as part of a consent agenda.
- C. The cooperative board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.
